

TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2023

- All studio sessions have to be scheduled in advance and run continuously. Any breaks are to be considered part of the booked time.
- The clock starts at the time sessions are scheduled to begin, regardless of the client being late.
- Overtime will be billed hourly, according to the current price list.
- In the case there's a deadline for the delivery of files, it must be stated in writing at the time of booking.
- For recording and mixing services, Arda Recorders will invoice 50% of the agreed-upon budget at the time of booking as a deposit. This deposit is non-refundable. The remaining balance is to be paid before any files or recording media leaves the premises.
- For sessions run by engineers or producers that aren't in our roster, the remaining balance is due before the first scheduled session.
- Mastering services are to be paid in advance unless agreed upon. For projects that include recording and/or mixing, the total amount that was quoted for the entire project must be settled before mastering starts.
- If a booking is canceled less than 15 days prior to the start date, the client will be invoiced for the full amount of the project.
- Any corrections made to recordings, mixes or masters previously approved by the client will be billed accordingly.
- Extra mixes (instrumental mix, TV mix, etc.) must be required before the beginning of the mixing process and will be charged accordingly.
- Crediting of the studio staff in any releases is to be done at the discretion of Arda Recorders.
- After the delivery of the final tracks, Arda Recorders is not responsible for the archive of the work sessions.
- Arda Recorders cannot be held responsible for services provided by other companies or individuals, even if they are informally associated with Arda Recorders.
- Arda Recorders is not responsible for any equipment or goods left on its premises.
- Any material damage caused by negligence or misuse will be the responsibility of the client.
- Any violent or abusive behavior towards the staff or the facilities (either from the client, artist or someone associated with their project) will result in the immediate termination of the working agreement, and the client will be billed for the full amount of the project.
